Report on Employers feedback on Curriculum

IQAC of the college collected feedback on curriculum from Employers through online mode. A questionnaire designed by the members of the IQAC was used for obtaining the responses of various potential employers. The questionnaire included questions regarding competency of the syllabus with regard to the job requirement and latest technology; effectiveness of the curriculum in promoting, innovative thinking, logical, analytical and creative skills as well as the communicative skills of the students. The questionnaire was sent to firms where the students of the college frequent for their ug/pg projects, field visits and internships. The link to the curriculum followed in the college was provided along with the questionnaire so as to enable effective feedback.

The collected data was analysed and the findings are as follows:


A total of 23 responses were received from 16 potential employers viz, Tata Consultancy Services, Cypheron Technologies Pvt Ltd, Hindustan Organic Chemicals Ltd, Molecular Bios Pvt Ltd, USV Pvt Ltd, Enfys Lifesciences Pvt Ltd Kochi, Nitta Gelatin India Limited, CEPCI Laboratory & Research Institute, Kollam, Nims Centre for Genomic Medicine NIMS Medicity Trivandrum, FilmShore Pvt Ltd, MERP Systems Pvt Ltd, Prominent scientific instruments manufacturers, Kozhikode.

52% of the potential employers preferred chemistry graduates/post graduates, 38 % favored computer science whereas Zoology and Botany graduates /post graduates received 19% and 14% interest respectively.


Majority of the employers (62%) agreed that the syllabus was competent for their job requirement. 67% of the respondents agree that the syllabus is competent with the latest technology. Regarding the effectiveness of the curriculum in promoting innovative thinking, 70% of the potential employers were in agreement. 84% were of the opinion that the curriculum is effective in developing logical, analytical and creative skills of the students. 87% of the respondents viewed the curriculum as effective in developing the communicative skills of the students.

Employer's Feedback Analysis on the Curriculum


Syllabus makes the student competent for the job requirement ²³ responses



Curriculum is compatible with the latest technology 23 responses




Curriculum promotes innovative thinking 23 responses
